GOVERNMENT OF BAYELSA STATE

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION LAW, 2023

A Law to make supplementary provisions for the services of Bayelsa State for the year ending on the 31st December, 2023.

Commencement

ENACTED by the House of Assembly of Bayelsa State of Nigeria and by the Authority of same as follows:

Transfer from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the Capital Development Fund of N49,900,000,000.00 1. The Accountant-General may, when authorized so to do by warrant under the hand of the Commissioner responsible for Finance, transfer from the Consolidated Revenue Fund during the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2023, any sum not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of N49,900,000,000.00 (Forty Nine Billion, Nine Hundred Million Naira) only.

Expenditure of N49,900,000,000.00 authorized out of the Capital Development Fund.

2. The Accountant-General may, when authorized so to do by warrant under the hand of the Commissioner responsible for Finance, transfer from the Capital Development Fund of Bayelsa State during the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2023, any sum not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of N49,900,000,000.00 (Forty Nine Billion, Nine Hundred Million Naira) being the total of the amounts set forth opposite the Administrative Codes

Second Schedule

023400100100, 051700100100, 023800100100, 012300100100, 053500100100 and 011100200900 in the Second Schedule.

Appropriation of N49,900,000,000

3. The sum mentioned in Section 3 above, in the whole not exceeding the sum of N49,900,000,000.00 (Forty Nine Billion, Nine Hundred Million Naira) only shall be appropriated to the purposes and in the manner expressed in the Second Schedule.

Balance un-issued to lapse.

4. The monies granted by Sections 2 and 3 are intended for the services in respect of which monies will become payable within the financial year ending on the 31st day of December, 2023 and no part of the amounts set out in the sections mentioned above shall be issued out of the

Consolidated Revenue Fund after the end of the financial year mentioned above.

Interpretation

- 5. In this law, unless the context otherwise required:
- "Accountant-General" means the Accountant-General of Bayelsa State of Nigeria, and
- "Governor" means the Governor of Bayelsa State of Nigeria.
